Less of the area is covered by natural grasslands, swamps and infrastructure.



50% is used for cereals



From agricultural area 39% is utilized for forage crops



13% is occupied by oilseed and technical crops

10% by pulses and smaller part is under potatoes and vegetables.



In Estonia can be found intesively managed, mixed type farms, composed by dairy farming and crop production but also alternative and organic farms, located on West-Coast of Estonia and on Islands, which consequently affects the soil quality.
